

HOW TO MEASURE YOUR TRADITIONAL DRAW LENGTH

- The desired way to measure draw length is to draw a bow to your anchor point. Have someone measure the distance from the string at full draw to the "back" of the bow. (The back of the bow is actually the side of the riser which is away from you). This is the method I utilize when building a bow for a customer from his/her requested draw weight and draw length).

Alternative Method

- Place one end of a yardstick at the top of your chest just below the throat extending the yardstick straight out in front of you.

NOTE: you can use any stick to find this measurement however you would need to use a tape measure to find the distance.

- Reach out on the yardstick which is extended straight out in front of you EQUALLY with the fingertips of BOTH hands as far as possible.
- The measurement reading on the yardstick at the end of your extended fingers is your approximate draw length.
